

Aims of the Camp -

The aims of the Mike Trader's Mid-America Basketball School will be to teach and develop individual skills and to have fun. The daily schedule will include league games and contests. Players will be divided into separate leagues according to age. Fundamentals will be stressed. In 2007-2008, Coach Trader helped guide the Hastings St. Cecilia team to a 22-2 record and a State Championship.

As one of the most popular and successful camps in the Midwest, Coach Trader will assemble an outstanding staff of college and high school coaches that will work with you to develop your skills and fundamentals. Coach Trader believes in hiring the best and most enthused coaches possible. In addition, Larry Ribble and Bill Gavers of Hastings College will help Coach Trader in directing the camps. Location & Facilities

Mike Trader's Mid-America Basketball Camps Individual Sessions will be held for overnight sessions at Central Community College (Columbus, NE), Doane University (Crete, NE) and Hastings College with Day Camps at Grand Island Central Catholic, Ogallala Prairie View, Morrill High School and Hastings Middle School. Campers for the overnight sessions will be housed in air-conditioned dormitories with professional supervision provided. All meals will be served by the regular college food service.
