

Aims of the Camp

The aims of the Mike Trader's Mid-America Basketball School will be to teach and develop individual skills and to have fun. The daily schedule will include league games and contests. Players will be divided into separate leagues according to age. Fundamentals will be stressed. Individual drills and training techniques to develop strength, endurance, guickness and jumping ability will be taught. Each camper will be analyzed with the assistance of individual video and attention given to individual technique/correction. Lectures, demonstrations and competition will be according to age level and ability so each camper will have an opportunity to excel.

Trader was recognized as District or Conference Coach of the Year five separate times and was honored in 1988 as the Omaha World Herald's State College Coach of the Year.

In 2007-2008, Coach Trader helped guide the Hastings St. Cecilia team to a 22-2 record and a State Championship.

Location & Facilities

Mike Trader's Mid-America Basketball Camps Individual Sessions will be held for overnight sessions at Central Community College (Columbus, NE), Doane University (Crete, NE) and Hastings College with Day Camps at Grand Island Central Catholic, Ogallala Prairie View, Morrill High School, Norfolk YMCA and Hastings Middle School. Campers for the overnight sessions will be housed in air-conditioned dormitories with professional supervision provided. All meals will be served by the regular college food service.
